The Dian Fossey Map Room has been built in honour of Dr. Dian Fossey, the pioneering primatologist who set up the Karisoke Center high in the Virunga volcanoes in 1967.

A permanent exhibition has been set up in the Map Room charting the 'Conservationists and Explorers of the Virunga Volcanoes' from 1850 to 1985 when Fossey died.
