

# Volcanoes Safaris Partnership Trust (VSPT) Fact Sheet

### **Uganda & Rwanda**

- Established in 2009, the Volcanoes Safaris
   Partnership Trust (VSPT) is a non-profit
   organisation that connects Volcanoes Safaris
   luxury lodges to the neighbouring communities
   and conservation activities.
- The VSPT seeks to create long-term, selfsustaining projects to enrich the livelihoods of local communities, promote the conservation of great apes, restore natural habitats and work with communities and institutions to reduce human-wildlife conflict.
- The VSPT receives funding through Volcanoes Safaris, which contributes \$50 from safari bookings, as well as private donations by our guests and others.
- As part of their stay at Volcanoes Lodges, guests get an opportunity to visit VSPT projects and to share the lives of the local communities.

# Kyambura Gorge Lodge, Queen Elizabeth National Park, Uganda

- <u>Kyambura Gorge Eco-Tourism Project</u> launched in February 2019.
- Kyambura Lion Monitoring Project Join a local scientific researcher in Queen Elizabeth National Park to locate and record a lion pride.
- Kyambura Coffee Tours Demonstrations show how African coffee is harvested and processed before sampling the 'best cup of coffee in Uganda'.
- Kyambura Wetland Walk and Restoration
   <u>Project</u> Participate in a guided walk, ideal for birders. Over 200 species of bird have returned to the wetland.
- Bee Keeping Visit a local apiary and learn about bee husbandry and the use of bees as an elephant deterrent.
- <u>Kyambura Community Playground</u> Watch or participate in a football match with members of the local community.











# Bwindi Lodge, Bwindi Impenetrable Forst, Uganda

- <u>Bwindi Tea Cooperative</u> Learn about local tea processing methods and sample black and green teas.
- <u>Bwindi Bar</u> Sample traditional Ugandan cuisine. The bar provides a practical training institution for local disadvantaged youths living near the Bwindi National Park in Buhoma.

#### Mount Gahinga Lodge, Kisoro, Uganda

- Gahinga Batwa Village Visit the newly built permanent settlement which hosts 147 members of the Gahinga Batwa community.
- <u>Batwa Heritage Site</u> Learn about the ancient ways of the Batwa tribe.
- <u>Batwa Dance Group</u> Watch and participate in local Batwa songs and dances.
- <u>Batwa Vocational Centre</u> Purchase crafts made by the Batwa.

### Virunga Lodge, Parc National des Volcans, Rwanda

- <u>Intore Dance Performance</u> Watch a traditional Rwandan dance performance.
- <u>Virunga Craft Project</u> Visit the craft centre and purchase handmade local crafts.
- <u>Virunga Sheep Project</u> Donate a sheep to one of the families living in the proximity of the lodge.
- <u>Virunga Water Tank Project</u> Donate a water tank to one of the families living in the proximity of the lodge.
- Virunga Micro-Finance Savings Scheme
