

Dian Fossey Map Room at Virunga Lodge – Meetings and Events

Virunga Lodge is the perfect destination for business retreats, special family celebrations, cocktail receptions and conservation lectures with DFGFI gorilla researchers and park wardens.

The Dian Fossey Map Room has been built in honour of Dr. Dian Fossey, the pioneer primatologist who set up the Karisoke Center high in the Virunga volcanoes in 1967.

A permanent exhibition has been set up in the Map Room charting the 'Conservationists and Explorers of the Virunga Volcanoes' from 1850 to 1985 when Fossey died.
